


AWAM File Manager & Automation Scheduler Updates

Changes to the April 28th publication of this document that are recorded in this May 8th version pertain to the AWAM File Manager and Automation Scheduler software applications.

Modifications were made to resolve an issue that was discovered in the AWAM File Manager (version 8.20.13.28) that needed immediate attention. The resolution is available in the newly released version (8.20.13.29). To support these changes, an update to the Automation Scheduler is also required. Version 8.20.3.149 has been updated to 8.20.3.150. For more information, refer to each product's Release Notes.



Both products must be installed to resolve the AWAM File Manager issue!

Certain Product Installers Have Changed

With the March release of Window Book's Automation Scheduler and DAT-MAIL software, we introduced the option to update your PostalWeb Connector and PostalWeb Desktop Dashboard software (respectfully) at the same time, to make the updating process easier and faster.

These new installation options require a specific installation update sequence; as well as, some other details that are required to be able to successfully run your Window Book products.

So, if you haven't yet updated to the March release of the Automation Scheduler and DAT-MAIL, we strongly recommend you review the [March publication of "What's New?"](#) before attempting to update to this April release. Updating to the March release *before* updating to this April release, is not necessary; however, the March publication of "What's New?" contains important information and instructions that you need to be aware of when you update these two products any time beyond the March release.



Multi-Carrier Trailer Manifesting now includes support for King Logistics users!

MCTM isn't just for use with LSC or ALG anymore. Now users can set up DAT-MAIL to include King Logistics as a carrier. This new carrier option allows users to send Mail.dat files to King Logistics via an SFTP site of their choosing.


Simply add King Logistics to DAT-MAIL's Carrier list (accessible from the 'File' > 'Carrier List' menus) by inserting a new carrier called King Logistics and entering the user-supplied SFTP credentials in the screen's 'Data Exchange' tab.





Once King Logistics has been added to the Carrier List, select 'File' > 'Program Settings' > 'Program Setup' to launch the *Setup* screen. Then, select the 'Logistics' tab. A new Logistics Data Exchange option for King Logistics is included on the screen. Use the corresponding browse button to navigate to and select 'King Logistics' from the Carrier List.



With King Logistics set up for use, users will be able to 'Send Mail.dat Files to Logistics Company' from within Multi-Carrier Trailer Manifesting.




Now you can update a pallet's gross weight in Multi-Carrier Trailer Manifesting!

In this April release of DAT-MAIL, we've added the ability to add/edit gross weight for single and mother pallets, and sibling pallets within Multi-Carrier Trailer Manifesting.

An **Update Gross Weight** button has been added to the *Browse Pallet Database* screen accessible by using the **Assign Pallets to Manifests** button in Multi-Carrier Trailer Manifesting menu.



Users can now enter a new value for the gross weight and also see the percent difference with the original value.






DAT-MAIL Editor users can now view their pallet list!

In this release of DAT-MAIL, we've provided DAT-MAIL Editor users who are not registered to use Multi-Carrier Trailer Manifesting, the ability to view their pallet list. DAT-MAIL's pallet view can provide extremely valuable information about what is scheduled to be shipped for any date range, as well as other important information for users.


DAT-MAIL Editor users who are not registered to use Multi-Carrier Trailing Manifesting will now have a new menu option of 'View Pallets' under the main 'File' menu.



For this new menu option to display, pallet tracking must be enabled in the software. The 'Enable Pallet Tracking' option is located in the 'Pallet Tracking/Intelligent Mail' tab of the *Setup* screen, which is accessible from the 'File' > 'Program Settings' > 'Program Setup' menu options.



Once the 'Pallet Tracking/Intelligent Mail' option is selected, the 'View Pallet' menu option will become available as part of the 'File' menu (see first image above on this page), and a new icon (i.e. a pallet of mail) will display on DAT-MAIL's menu bar.



Both the icon and the 'View Pallets' menu option will launch the *Browse Pallet Database* screen, which lists all of the pallets in the system.

WHAT'S NEW IN DETAIL

1 The pallets that display can be controlled by using the screen's powerful Filter function.

2 The different dates associated with each pallet can be updated by using the **Date** button.

3 Pallet-related reports and utilities will also be available (i.e. **Reports & Utilities** button).



If at least one Filter option is not selected/set (refer to "Browse Pallet Database" screen image above), the REPORTS & UTILITIES button will be disabled.

- Report: Allows users to create a Trailer Pallet Report based on pallets filtered and tagged in the pallet list. When the 'Report' option is selected, users can specify a sort order to be applied to the report (i.e. Job Number, Job ID, Estimated Ship Date, Postage Statement Mailing Date). When processing is complete, the report can be displayed on the screen or be immediately sent to a printer.

WHAT'S NEW IN DETAIL

- Export: Allows users to create a CSV export based on pallets filtered and tagged in the pallet list. A default name and location are provided but can be changed by the user if preferred. When processing is complete, the CSV file will be exported to the location specified.

- Import: This allows users to export pallet data using the 'Export' option, update/change some or all of the major dates reported in the file, and then import the changes back to the same pallet data in DAT-MAIL. The major dates are: Mail Date; Drop Date; and In-Home Date.



When using LSC/DIME, certain functions in wbSCAN generate calls that communicate with other programs via request/response files. Having access to and being able to view these files can be critical should troubleshooting be necessary.



WHAT'S NEW IN DETAIL

In this release of DAT-MAIL/wbSCAN, we've made modifications so that these XML request/response files are stored in SQL. What does this mean exactly? wbSCAN now includes a new 'Request Log' tab that is located in each function's *Scan Log Details* screen (e.g. Add Pallets To Manifest). When these "calls" (i.e. 'IPS Action') are made, the generated request/response XML file is displayed in the list.



The details of each individual file, including the file's location on the server or computer, can be viewed by clicking the view button or icon  located at the beginning of the file's line item in the log. The actual XML file can also be opened and viewed by clicking the **View File** button in the details screen.




Having the location of the file makes it easy for users and Window Book's Support Team if troubleshooting is necessary.



WHAT'S NEW IN DETAIL

Since these XML response/request files are now stored in SQL, we've also incorporated a new database clean up setting in the LSC DIME settings area in DAT-MAIL. Simply navigate to 'File' > 'Program Settings' > 'Program Setup' to launch the *Setup* screen. Select the 'Logistics' tab and click the **LSC DIME Settings** button.



Depending on your level of usage, set the number of days to keep DIME Request Log records. DAT-MAIL will delete any of the records (i.e. request/response XML files) older than the number of days specified. The default setting is 30 days.



Routinely deleting these files on a timely basis is important for maintaining good database health and system performance!

WHAT'S NEW IN DETAIL

wbSCAN's Dashboard now provides drill-down capabilities so you can see the pallet information for each job!

With this release of DAT-MAIL/wbSCAN, the capability now exists to click on a "Job" displayed in the Dashboard and view the list of pallets associated with that job.

Dashboard cell shows pieces, pallets and % of total pieces

When a particular 'Job' is clicked or selected, a Job View screen will display, and the list of pallets associated with the job will be listed. These are all of the pallets associated with the job, not just the pallets that have been scanned.

Generate Export File Print

We've also provided the ability to generate a CSV file of the pallet data that can be downloaded from wbSCAN. When the **Generate Export File** button is clicked, the CSV file will be created and download link will be provided on the screen. Users must click the link to download the file.




Generated files will be deleted from the screen when the Job View is closed or navigated away from, and/or if a user-session expires. The pallet data export file will have to be generated again to be able to be able to create a download for it.



Users can also simply print a copy of the pallet data from the *Job View* screen by clicking the **Print** button.



The system creates a PDF that can be printed to a printer of their choosing.

We made running our Undocumented Piece Audit Report smarter.


DAT-MAIL's Undocumented Piece Audit Report only uses information pertaining to undocumented pieces. The Informed Visibility website; however, allows users to generate files for a lot of different purposes. This means users could inadvertently select unnecessary files during the process of running the Undocumented Piece Audit Report, affecting processing speed and overall system performance.

To help lessen the chances of this happening, we've implemented a file mask when selecting files for processing that will only show those files that fit the format necessary for generating the Undocumented Piece Audit Report.




This new mask is applied when the files are selected for processing.



When the Input browse button is clicked, a *Select files to process* browse is displayed, with the default file type set to a value of "Mail Quality Data". And only those files that fit the "mask" will be displayed for selection (i.e. '*.MQD_SE_U_*.txt').



This will help insure only those files relevant for generating the Undocumented Piece Audit Report are selected.





Not a large need for shipping Priority Mail Open and Distribute®? Do you only use PMOD to ship sacks every now and again, but not enough to warrant a major investment into it? Well then, we've got a GREAT solution for you!

With this release of DAT-MAIL, ALL users can use our PMOD module for shipping sacks to take advantage of drop ship discounts and/or better control in-home delivery dates. All that's needed is for you to set up an ePostage account with our partner International Bridge and you're pretty much ready to go!

Simply go to DAT-MAIL's Setup screen (i.e. 'File' > 'Program Settings' > 'Program Setup') and select the 'PMOD' tab. Use the browse button for the 'Default IB Account' setting.




The *Browse the IB Account File* screen will display. Use the **Register New IB Account** button to launch a web browser, which will automatically navigate to the International Bridge landing page required to start the account creation process.





WHAT'S NEW IN DETAIL

Once the ePostage account has been set up, it needs to be added to DAT-MAIL. Use the **Insert** button on the *Browse the IB Account File* screen. Give the account a name and enter your IB credentials. Close the screen when finished.



Once the account has been created and added to DAT-MAIL, additional setup is necessary in the DAT-MAIL *Setup* screen's 'PMOD' tab. Refer to the [PMOD Setup & User Guide](#) for instructions.



Once setup is complete, you're ready to take advantage of the PMOD module for mailing sacks!



WHAT'S NEW IN DETAIL

To assist users, we've added a warning message to a change form in the CQT view.

Making changes to the CQT Service Level Indicator field could impact the full service status of the segment that CQT is related to. If needed, DAT-MAIL will automatically keep the SEG 'Full Service Participation Indicator' up-to-date and in sync with updated CQT records. Users may not realize this so, based on a customer's request, we've added a warning message to the CQT Update screen:

"Warning, this may alter the SEG full service indicator".



WHAT'S NEW IN DETAIL

We've made changing Piece Weights a little easier.

To assist users making changes to Piece Weights in a file, we've added a new sort order in the *Change Weights* screen accessible from the Advanced Navigator. The file data displayed in the new 'Mail Piece Weight' tab is sorted by Weight (i.e. lowest to highest). This request came from a Client, and we listened!



Only relying on a global import setting to automatically set e-induction information can be insufficient for some mailers, so we've made some modifications to our AWAM profile types to remedy this.

'Mark pallets for eInduction' used to be included in the AWAM Import profile options; however, we've moved it so that it is now part of the Post-processing options. This means 'Mark pallets for eInduction' is now an available option in AWAM Import, Merge, and Post Process profiles.


We've made a slight modification to the combined installer logic.

In the [March release of the Automation Scheduler](#), a new installer was introduced that included PostalWeb Connector software. The ability to install PostalWeb Connector was available to all Automation Scheduler users.


In this April release, a slight modification has been made to the installer. The option to install or update PostalWeb Connector is only made available when the Automation Scheduler installer detects an existing installation of the PostalWeb Connector. If an existing installation of PostalWeb Connector is not detected, the option to also install PostalWeb Connector is hidden and not available to the user.

Working smarter so you don't have to.

Auto Validation users can set their presort export folder to the same location as the DAT-PreCheck import folder without experiencing any conflicts.

Prior to this April release of DAT-PreCheck (DPC), having the same folder set for both would sometimes cause problems because the entire Mail.dat may not have gotten placed into the input folder before DPC would grab it. When this occurred, the job would fail in DPC.

So, Window Book has implemented a time delay feature to assist in avoiding this conflict. Now, DPC will wait one minute after a new file is identified before it will attempt to pick it up. If after the one minute the file still cannot be grabbed by DPC (the file is still locked or in use by presort), DPC will try up to 10 times to grab it (for up to two hour and 45 minutes).



Mail.dat files that are not being presorted to specific facilities makes it hard for mailers with multiple facilities to differentiate workflows for them. To assist with this, Window Book has added two additional fields to our Rules function so mailers can use these fields to help identify the facility a Mail.dat file is being processed in.

SEG-1118 Verification Facility Name and CSM-1167 Locale Key are now included in the Rules function of the AWAM File Manager. These fields can be selected by a user when defining a Rule to determine what should be done with Mail.dat files specific to certain facilities.
